Cover Photo: The cover photo features a petroglyph design representing generations within a family. Dale Zarrella, a Maui-based sculptor and painter as well as a friend of Keawala‘i Congregational Church, etched the design into the *pōhaku* (stone) drawn from a petroglyph rubbing. The stone carving is in the sanctuary of the church along with a second stone with a petroglyph design featuring a family.

The photo includes cuttings from the *‘ōhi‘a lehua mamo* and the *‘ōhi‘a lehua ‘ua* - the yellow and red lehua cuttings of the *‘ōhi‘a* tree - as well as the leaves of the *hala* (pandanus) tree that are a part of the church’s landscape.
