

## *KA HELUHELU HA'AWINA – KAUOHA HOU* Liturgist Scripture Reading

#### Jeremiah 23:1-6

<sup>1</sup> "Woe to the shepherds who scatter and destroy the sheep of My pasture!" <sup>2</sup> Therefore thus says the Lord against those who tend My people: "You have scattered My sheep and driven them out. You did not care for them. Behold, I shall punish you according to your evil practices. <sup>3</sup> I will receive the remnant of My people from every land where I have driven them. I will establish them in their pasture, and they shall increase and be multiplied. <sup>4</sup> I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them. They shall fear no more, nor be terrified," says the Lord. <sup>5</sup> "Behold, days are coming," says the Lord, "when I will raise up for David the Righteous Orient, and a King shall reign. He will understand and bring about judgement and righteousness on the earth. <sup>6</sup> In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel shall dwell in confidence. This is His name by which the Lord will call him: 'The Lord Our Righteousness.'

#### **Luke 1:67-79**

<sup>67</sup> Then his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied:

on his people and redeemed them. <sup>69</sup> He has raised up a mighty savior for us in the house of his child David, <sup>70</sup> as he spoke through the mouth of his holy prophets from of old, <sup>71</sup> that we would be saved from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us. <sup>72</sup> Thus he has shown the mercy promised to our ancestor and has remembered his holy covenant, <sup>73</sup> the oath that he swore to our ancestor Abraham, to grant us <sup>74</sup> that we, being rescued from the hands of our enemies, might serve him without fear, <sup>75</sup> in holiness and righteousness in his presence all our days.

<sup>76</sup> And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High, for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways, <sup>77</sup> to give his people knowledge of salvation by the forgiveness of their sins. <sup>78</sup> Because of the tender mercy of our God, the dawn from on high will break upon us, <sup>79</sup> to shine upon those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace."
